





## MULTIPLICATION PROCESS CO-LAB

The Multiplication Process Co-Lab is a virtual & in-person experience that gathers Mississippi churches together to help each church define their unique purpose. Your church will bring a team of 3-5 leaders together to collaborate and design your church's disciple-making vision and strategy.

The Multiplication Process Co-Lab includes a **two-dayin-person gathering**, **March 24-25**, **2025** at First Baptist Church, Madison, MS, followed by virtual resources and coaching the month before and after. The Multiplication Process Co-Lab will help develop three key objectives:

## DISCIPLE-MAKING CULTURE

The strongest strategies and ministries won't last if you don't have a disciple-making culture. Replicate will train you on the five myths that leaders believe that stall disciple-making movements and the five shifts you must make to create a thriving disciple-making culture.

#### ORGANIZATIONAL CLARITY

Replicate Navigators will work with your team to create a disciple-making vision and strategy that is unique to your context. One that tells your entire congregation why you exist, where you are going, and how you will get there.

## D-GROUP IMPLEMENTATION

Replicate will provide you with a customizable ministry template to help you train and multiply disciple-makers. You will receive editable files and resources so you can quickly get people making disciples.

# **CORE OBJECTIVES**

To bring your disciple-making culture to life, we use a tool called the Vision Plan. This provides the words that move your conviction from the hearts of your leadership to the hearts of your people and together shape the culture of your church.

The Vision Plan is broken into three levels. There is one core objective per level.
